



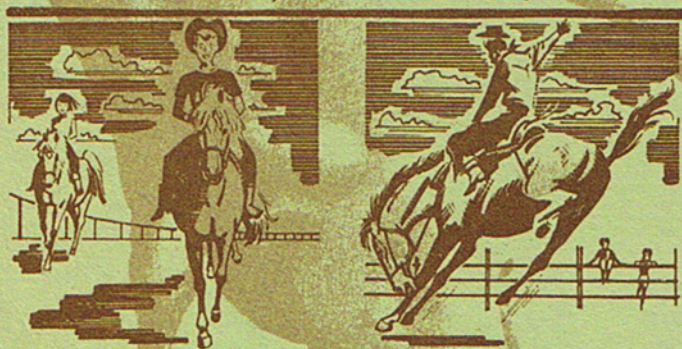

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Judging of exhibits will begin at 1:30 p.m., August 21.
- Livestock and poultry must be on exhibit by 8 a.m., Saturday, August 22. Livestock judging will begin promptly at 8:30 a.m., and take place in the arena.
- All exhibits must remain in place until 4 p.m., Saturday, except milk cows.
- The Bosque Farms Community Fair Board or Rodeo Association assumes no responsibility for exhibits.
- Only one entry per person in each class will be accepted, except where noted.
- No entries, except livestock, will be accepted from previous years.
- Single entries in a class will be judged on merit only.
- All exhibits which are not listed will be considered display items only.
- No one is allowed in the building or arena while judging is in progress except judges and superintendents.
- No one, except superintendents, is to be within 25 feet of the judges while they are judging livestock.
- Decision of the judges shall be final, any rule not covered by this book shall be referred to State Fair regulations.
- Ribbons awarded for first, second and third-place winners in all departments and categories.
- Persons exhibiting at the Fair will be:
 - All Bosque Farms boys and girls active in 4-H club work.
 - All participants in the Fair must be residents or property owners of the Bosque Farms community or residents permanently established in nearby communities.
 - Any merchant who makes a cash or merchandise donation to the Fair is invited to display.
