2. Livestock and poultry must be on exhibit by 8 a.m., Saturday, August 22. Livestock judging will begin promptly at 8:30 a.m., and take place in the arena.

3. All exhibits must remain in place until 4 p.m., Saturday, except milk

4. The Bosque Farms Community Fair Board or Rodeo Association assumes no responsibility for exhibits.

5. Only one entry per person in each class will be accepted, except

where noted.

6. No entries, except livestock, will be accepted from previous years.

7. Single entries in a class will be judged on merit only.

8. All exhibits which are not listed will be considered display items only.

9. No one is allowed in the building or arena while judging is in progress

except judges and superintendents.

10. No one, except superintendents, is to be within 25 feet of the judges while they are judging livestock,

11. Decision of the judges shall be final, any rule not covered by this book

shall be referred to State Fair regulations.

12. Ribbons awarded for first, second and third-place winners in all departments and categories.

13. Persons exhibiting at the Fair will be:

a. All Bosque Farms boys and girls active in 4-H club work.

b. All participants in the Fair must be residents or property owners of the Bosque Farms community or residents permanently established in nearby communities,

c. Any merchant who makes a cash or merchandise donation to the




