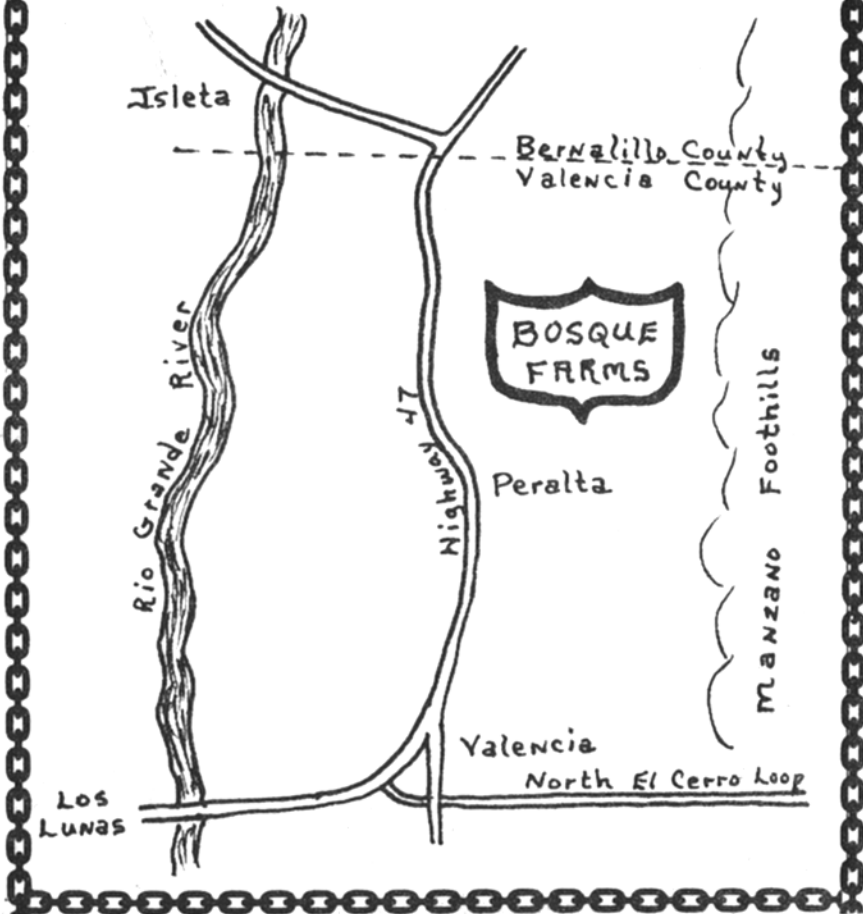


GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. INSIDE EXHIBITS will be accepted on Thursday afternoon August 18, between 4:00 - 7:00 p.m. and Friday morning 8:00 a.m. - 12 noon. OUTSIDE EXHIBITS must be pre-registered during these same hours at the pre-registration table in the Arena building.
2. Only one entry per person in each class will be accepted.
3. No entries will be accepted from previous years, except in Livestock Breeding Classes.
4. Single entries in a class will be judged on MERIT only.
5. Decision of judges shall be final. Any rule not covered in this book shall be referred to the General Superintendent, who is authorized to interpret rules and make decisions on behalf of the Bosque Farms Fair Association.
6. The Bosque Farms Fair Association will exercise reasonable care in the protection of exhibits but assumes no responsibility for exhibits lost or damaged. Neither the Bosque Farms Fair Association nor the Bosque Farms Rodeo Association shall be held liable for any personal injury or for loss or damage to any property while on the premises.
7. All entries must be checked out and released by the respective department superintendent between 4:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. Saturday, August 20. A claim check is required. No responsibility is assumed for exhibits not picked up by the deadline.
8. Persons who may exhibit at the Bosque Farms Fair are:
 - A. All boys & girls active in Bosque Farms 4-H Club.
 - B. Residents or owners of property in the Village of Bosque Farms or nearby communities as outlined on the Boundary Map. (Note: Rodeo, Foot Races, and 4-H Horse Show are all open to anyone who wishes to enter.)
 - C. Any merchant who makes a cash or merchandise donation to the fair is invited to set up a commercial display only. (\$5 refundable clean-up deposit & fair board approval required.)
 - D. Non-profit organizations within the fair boundaries may operate an information or game booth with fair board approval. Requests should be presented at a regular Fair Association meeting. (\$5 fee and \$5 refundable clean-up deposit required.)

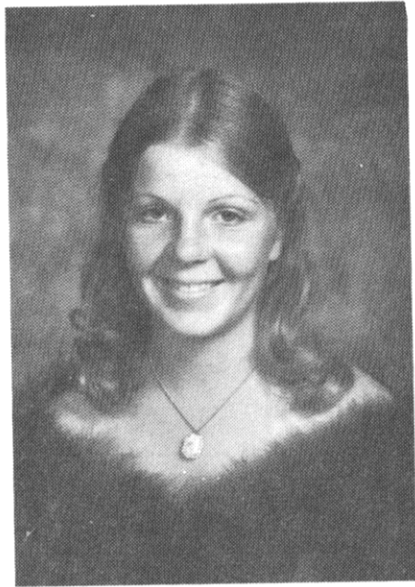

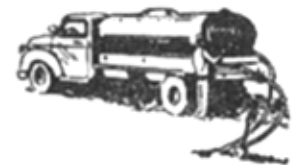
